What are the Unique & Extraordinary District Adult Recognitions?

"Silver Bullet" – People who are always there to encourage, take on tasks for their unit or the district. They are exceptional folks who go WAY beyond their position in Scouting.

"Golden Spur" – Given to a nominee who has spurred Scouters and Scouts on to greater heights.

"Acorns to Oaks" – For a Commissioner who worked with a unit to get it started, or revitalized an existing unit to an effective functioning level.

"Golden Eagle" - Life-time achievement for service to the district.

Scouter of the Year – Recognition of the top adult Scouter for the year.

District Award of Merit – Top District Award – Based on the following BSA requirements...

- Be a registered Scouter (at least five years recommended).
- Have tendered noteworthy service to Scouts. The nature and value of "noteworthy service to Scouts" may
 consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of a large numbers of Scouts, or it may
 have been given to a small group over an extended period of time.
- Have contributed some service to youth outside of Scouting.
- Nomination must be submitted on BSA nomination form 33720.
