BALOO training is now comprised of two components - an online and hands-on component. **Both** components must be completed to qualify as a "Trained" Cub Scout outdoor leader and to receive the BALOO recognition patch. The online component contains introductory and basic information **and must be completed prior to the practical component**. Completing the online portion before the BALOO training makes the hands-on training more valuable and meaningful.
